Fern Cottage: A House of Creativity

This issue contains the history of Fern Cottage, a homestead overlooking Otter Creek. The quarterly explains in detail the Dorr and Steele families' history, their involvement with the arts, and how their interests were reflected in the building of their home, Fern Cottage. At the time of publication, the house had been remodeled and was used for meetings, retreats, and the "Connecting Kids to Life" program. The events described in the issue recount the Dorr and Steele family's artistic and transcendentalist views on life, which influenced the construction of Fern Cottage, and the building's uses as an inspiration for the arts.
