Chaffee's story continues on July 1, 1908, when she talks about many occurrences at home. Her family seems wealthy, since she talks about many trips that she takes in the family auto. She tells us in July that she went fishing and camped while at home with her family. By October 2, 1908, she returns to school, where she again talks about rushing for her sorority, and is appointed Librarian for Zeta Books at one of her meetings. Charlotte also discusses the presidential election in favor of TR in November, and eventually tells us about her trip home for Christmas.
