Glen's Garage presents a secret worth uncovering for people such as author David Zsido who happens to have a passion for antique cars. Sidney Butterfield operated and owned a business in the 1920s that provided gasoline and help for many people having difficulty with their cars. The garage lay vacant through many seasons of weathering, but everything inside was relatively preserved, and tools, headlights, magazines, newspapers and other artifacts piled up in these buildings, reflecting the lifestyle of the time.
