Pine Hill Stone Crusher and Early Stone Crushing Practices

This issue of the *Rutland Historical Society Quarterly* recounts the story of the stone crusher and plant located at Pine Hill. This piece was written by Paul J. Crossman Jr., a Rutland native and amateur historian. Crossman includes detailed street maps, images of the crusher, stone source lists and their quantities, a list of the workers at Pine Hill, and the inventory of all the equipment that was housed there, with the value of each item.
