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Rutland Railroad

The cover of this issue, a pencil sketch, shows a part of Rutland Village from the perspective of the Rutland and Burlington Railroad Station drawn on July 6, 1853. There is an interesting editor's note of its origin.

Unfolding the entire issue, one can view photographs of the Rutland Railroad yard; engines of the Clarendon and Pittsford Railroad on "parade", and an individual picture of the J. Burdett built in 1689. A stock certificate and railroad ticket are also featured.

The entire membership of the Historical Society is listed, and a "Who's Who" that mentions Miss Berenice R. Tuttle and her work in the community at large as well as Mr. Carleton Wilson the proprietor of Wilson's Clothing store on Merchants Row, a collector of Rutland photos and mementos.
