### **The Carpatho-Rusyn Community**

**The Prophetic Light, or Prorocheskoe Svietlo in Capatho-Rusyn, as headlined on the cover, was a religious journal published in the language of immigrants who came to Vermont from Eastern Europe, preceding and following the First World War.**

**Paul R. Magocsi, the article's author, the grandson of Paul Lengyel, a leading member of the group, describes the history and influence of these settlers.**

**A major change in their life was their decision to form their own church, after disputes arose with the Greek Catholic Church. Their own beliefs became less formal believing in a more personal relationship with God having learned to read the bible on their own.**
