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Rutland's Early Clockmakers: Lord and Goddard

The history of Rutland's Early Clockmakers, Lord and Goddard, is the topic of this quarterly issue.

In the summer of 1996 Mrs. George Harer of Long Island, N.Y. presented an authentic Nichols Goddard tall clock (illustrated on the cover) made in Rutland in the early nineteenth century.
