“The Covered Bridges of Old Rutland Town: A Calendar” written by Robert J. Cassidy, an active member of the Society for many years, presents a compendium of Rutland’s bridges; the history of their origin; and the various designs of their construction.

After a description of each bridge and its location, Mr. Cassidy includes anecdotes associated with all of them, including fights, robberies, murders and “youthful shenanigans”.

The text serves as an introduction to the coming year’s calendar, featuring a photograph of a specific bridge, such as the Dorr Bridge for January 2003, followed by others for each succeeding month. An attractive combination of Rutland History and of practical use.
