The Secrets of Glen Garage

"The Secrets of Glen Garage" is authored by David Zsido. Due to his interest in antique cares, he eventually explores an old wooden frame garage, the original Glen Garage and a larger former barn which became the home of Glen Garage.

Once on the the premises he found physical remains of the business, operated and owned by Sidney Butterfield in the 1920s.
