A History of Rutland High School, Rutland, VT (1855-2008)

A History of Rutland High School 1855-2008 is reviewed in this article by Paul. J. Crossman.

The Rutland High School was authorized by the Vermont Legislature in 1841, with the early centralization of local school districts.

Opening with the Rutland Academy which was formed in 1852, Mr. Crossman traces the development of the school system through the years. These included the renaming of the Academy as Rutland High School in 1855; opening a new High School in 1929; adding a Junior High School in 1957 and culminating with the newest building on Stratton Road in 1994.

This interesting and detailed account includes informative descriptions of the growth of the educational programs, and supplemented with photographs of the various schools through the years.
