“Faces of the Past: A Calendar” compiled by Jacob Sherman constitutes a visual collection of individuals who played a critical role in shaping the community of today.

They include individuals from all walks of life, most not born here, who in some way left their imprint on Vermont. Living before the advent of photography they are pictured here each month from sketches and portraits that were available.

The Quarterly cover introduces John Murray 1720-1794 who named Rutland after his home town of Rutland, Massachusetts followed each month with basic biographies of those that helped create the current State and its institutions.
