Henry Knox's Cannon Trek 1775-6

The cover illustrates the reenactment of Henry Knox's monumental Cannon Trek of 1775-6.

Conceived as a Bicentennial observance of the occasion, it was planned and executed by High School Seniors from Woodstock, Hartford, Poultney, and sixteen other schools across Southern Vermont.

Rutland Vo-Tech Students built a replica of a cannon that was then hauled by student participants from Brattleboro to Fort Ticonderoga as a reenactment of the historic moment.

Numerous photographs of the participants document the passage from November 10,1975 to December 5,1975.
