Bells and Belfries

The Cover illustrates a primary topic of this issue, an investigation of the bell towers of Rutland Vermont's churches, the majority of those bells having been forged in Troy, New York.

One, the oldest former Catholic Church was found lacking a bell tower, and therefore no bell; three others had been converted to ring electrically. Only one, Grace Congregational Church, converted to a carillon.
