“The Formation of The Internal Revenue Service” by Thomas A. Carpenter traces the beginnings of Taxation from the times of the Colonies under British Rule; Taxation after Independence; Taxes to finance both the War of 1812 and the Civil War; the late 19th and early 20th Century; and the official naming of the IRS in 1953. It concludes with Citizens views of Taxes; the Collection of taxes, and the inevitable problems of tax evasion and tax fraud. A thoroughly researched and well documented account by a long standing member of the Society.
