Dr. Emmanuel Levine, 36, New York city psychiatrist and former West Rutland resident, was killed early yesterday when his car smashed into a tree on Route 16, about a mile from Cambridge.

He is the state's 12th highway victim this year.

Dr. Levine, who had been visiting relatives at Craftsbury, was discovered dead in the demolished car about 6:15 a. m. by Carrol D. Wilder of Newport, a passing motorist who summoned police. Physicians estimated Dr. Levine had been dead about three hours.

Born at Brooklyn, N. Y., in 1914, Dr. Levine moved to West Rutland in 1915 with his parents, Leon and Mirium (Fellman) Levine.

A 1932 graduate and salutatorian

A 1932 graduate and salutatorian of West Rutland High school, he won a scholarship to the University of Vermont where he was graduated from the Medical college in 1937. He was an intern at Bishop DeGoesbriand hospital at Burlington for two years and at the Vermont State hospital at Waterbury for two years.

Enlisting in the Army in 1942 as a captain, Dr. Levine served in the South Pacific theater for three years. When he returned to the US he was assigned to the staff of Lyons Veterans administration hospital at Elizabeth, N. J., as a psychiatrist.

He opened his New York office in 1950.

While at West Rutland High school, he was active in school activities and sports and was a

member of the varsity football, basketball and baseball teams.

He leaves his wife, the former Louise Dustan of Craftsbury; a son, Charles, 5; a daughter, Laura, 4; a sister, Miss Vivian Levine of Elizabeth, N. J.; three brothers, Dr. Samuel Levine of Lyons hospital, Dr. Julian Levine of Greenwich, Conn., and Lt. Comdr. Aaron A. Levine, now serving at Hong Kong, and two uncles, Boris Fellman of West Rutland and Dr. Benjamin Levine of Ludlow.

Funeral services will be held today at 3 p. m. at the Mullin Funeral home at West Rutland. Burial will be in Rutland Jewish cemetery at East Clarendon.
