

RECORDS FOR VETERANS BURIED IN RUTLAND COUNTY CEMETERIES

These records are typed and hand-written index cards that were retrieved after having been in storage for many years. At this time a verifiable original source is not known. Each card tells a veteran's own story with birth and death dates, war fought, rank, organization, history of service, enlisted and discharge dates, cause of death, next of kin, cemetery, type of marker, and source of information. Wars start with the Revolutionary War and go to the Korean War. The latest deaths recorded are in the early 1950s, so veterans who died after that are not included. The cards are divided into three documents: Evergreen Cemetery in Rutland City, Smaller Rutland City Cemeteries, and Rutland County Cemeteries. They are searchable, but only words that are typed and have not degraded are detectable. Within cemetery the cards are in the same order as found, which is alphabetical by last name. These records are for information only and should not be assumed to be complete.
